1. 2010-11 Dues & Fall Conference Fees
 - If we drop all membership fees by \$15, it would cost WSDDCA approximately \$1665 out of surplus for 2010-11. Fall Conference fees may be a bit more this year depending on our food choices.
 - i. How many go to the fall conference? Pay more for the conference?
 - ii. Decision: Lower fees, tell group that we may have to increase next year. That way people may be more willing to come to the fall conference and pay for a hotel.
 - iii. If we do the solo ensemble, that would help pay for fees and we may not have to increase fees the following year.
 - Primary member would be \$50; Associate member would be \$30
2. Vendor membership fees
 - We will increase the general fee to \$75, vendor booth to \$50. Rationale: Cheer booths are way more expensive, it's a great opportunity for the businesses.
